Over the Counter Medications

The Board of Nursing and the School Health Resource Manual recommend that a parent/guardian give their consent for the administration of Over-the-Counter medications to the students in a school setting. Below is the list of available Over-the-Counter medications for your student during school day with your consent.

Please **Initial all that apply.** Your child will not be given any medication that you have not approved. You will be contacted as needed. Medication will be administered in age appropriate dose as recommended by manufacturer or as specified by parent/guardian or physician. All medication will be administered by school nurse or medication trained designee.

Sun Screen: If you would like your child to have sun screen applied, you may provide it to class room staff who will assist/apply it for your child.
